Grape variety Riesling

Naming Kaiton is the original Celtic name for the area around the Kuenhof and the village of Tschötsch above it

Cultivation area South of Bressanone. South-east and partially south-west faced vineyards on an altitude from 550 to 890 metres (1,800 to 2,900 feet)

Climate Warm microclimate with large temperature fluctuations between day and night during the gestation period

Soil Shallow layers of soil characterized by slate and quartz phyllite among the main rock types with a small content of loam

Training system Wire frame (Guyot) with 7,000 to 8,000 vines per hectare

Harvest time October

Yield 7,000 to 8,000 kg/ha

Age of vines Up to 26 years

Vinification Gentle pressing and processing of the grapes. The fermentation and ageing on fine lees take place in stainless steel tanks and large acacia wood barrels, no malolactic fermentation Bottling End of April, including a ripening time per bottle of two months

Storage capacity Medium to high ageing potential

Description In colour pale yellow with green hues, fine mineral bouquet, fruity aromas of white peach, fine citrus notes. Salty structure with a freshening acidic taste and a lingering finish.
